JOB DESCRIPTION (Scope of duties, expectations, remarks)

- Conducting teaching activities for full-time, part-time, and postgraduate studies in the field of biological anthropology, biometrics, and pre-medical first aid, including: Anthropology, Anthropology of Physical Culture, Anthropological Workshops, Diagnostics of Physical Development and related subjects, Modern Information Technologies, Computer Science with elements of data analysis.
- Readiness to act as a supervisor/camp counselor during summer and winter student camps included in the core curricula of the programs run by the Faculty of Physical Education.
- Readiness to conduct classes in English.
- Participation in administrative and organizational tasks of the Department and the Faculty.
- Participation in and initiation of scientific research within the discipline of physical culture sciences at the University.
- Preparing own research projects.
- Publishing scientific papers.
- Obtaining a PhD degree within a period of no longer than 4 years from the date of employment.
- Adherence to the AWF Employee Code of Ethics and the Code of Academic Ethics.

QUALIFICATION CRITERIA - Applicants must meet the requirements specified in Art. 113 and 116 para. 2, Art. 118 et seq. of the Act of July 20, 2018 – Law on Higher Education

and Science (Journal of Laws 2022, item 574 as amended) and satisfy the following criteria:

1. Higher education: Master's degree in Physical Education, Sport, Physiotherapy, or a related field, and/or a Doctoral School diploma, or a PhD degree in Physical Culture Sciences.
2. Experience: Documented scientific record (e.g., participation in research projects, conference presentations, scientific publications), teaching experience (e.g., internships, courses), organizational and science popularization activity within physical culture sciences.
3. Camp Qualifications: Valid certifications useful for student camps, e.g., swimming instructor and/or swimming coach, snowboard instructor, lifeguard, camp manager/school trip leader, etc.
4. Competencies: Strong didactic and methodical skills, including digital and technological literacy, as well as soft skills (social competencies, e.g., completed training in interpersonal communication).
5. Additional assets: Other skills useful in scientific and didactic work, including volunteer work.
6. Polish Language: Proficiency in Polish at a minimum level of C1.
7. Declaration: Statement that AWF Warsaw will be the primary place of employment.
