### **JOB DESCRIPTION (Tasks, Expectations, Remarks)**

- Conducting teaching activities for full-time, part-time, and postgraduate studies in the field of first aid and biochemistry (specifically: Pre-medical First Aid, Biochemistry, Biological Foundations of Human Functioning - Pre-medical Aid).
- Readiness to conduct classes in English.
- Participation in administrative and organizational tasks of the Department and the Faculty.
- Participation in and initiation of scientific research within the discipline of physical culture sciences at the University.
- Preparing own research projects and publishing scientific papers.
- Adherence to the AWF Employee Code of Ethics and the Code of Academic Ethics.

**QUALIFICATION CRITERIA - The competition is open to persons who meet the requirements specified in Articles 113 and 116 paragraph 2, Article 118 and others of the Act of 20 July 2018 – The Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2022, item 574, as amended) and meet the following qualification criteria:**

1. Higher education: Master's degree in Physical Education or a related field and/or a Doctoral School diploma or a PhD degree in Physical Culture Sciences.
2. Qualifications: Certified First Aid Instructor.
3. Experience: Documented scientific record (e.g., participation in research projects, conference presentations, scientific publications), teaching experience (e.g., internships, courses, postgraduate studies), and organizational experience in physical culture sciences.
4. Competencies: Strong didactic and methodical skills, including digital, technological, and soft skills (social competencies).
5. Additional assets: Other skills useful in scientific and didactic work.
6. Polish Language: Proficiency in Polish at a minimum level of C1.

7. English language: Proficiency level enabling the conduct of academic classes.
8. Declaration: Statement that AWF Warsaw will be the primary place of employment.
