

Research and Teaching Assistant, Chair of Clinical Physiotherapy, Pediatrics

The Dean of the Faculty of Rehabilitation at the Józef Piłsudski University of Physical Education in Warsaw (hereinafter referred to as “AWF Warsaw”) announces a competition for the post of research and teaching assistant in the unit Department of Clinical Physiotherapy. The deadline for submitting applications for the competition is 02.09.2026 r. (the date of receipt of a complete application, meeting the formal requirements of the competition, by AWF Warsaw shall be decisive).

- Delivering lectures and practical classes in the following subjects: Clinical Foundations of Physiotherapy in Pediatrics, Physiotherapy in Pediatrics, Rehabilitation Planning in Developmental Age.
- Active involvement in the research, teaching, and organizational activities of the Department of Clinical Physiotherapy, the Faculty, and the University.
- Availability and commitment to departmental activities.
- Participation in the preparation and implementation of various research projects, scientific conferences, and training events.

The competition is open to persons who meet the conditions set out in Articles 113 and 116(2), Article 118 et al. of the Act of 20 July 2018 Law on Higher Education and Science (i.e. Journal of Laws of 2022, item 574, as amended) and the following eligibility criteria:

Our requirements:

1. Master's degree in Physiotherapy.
2. Valid license to practice as a physiotherapist and at least 10 years of professional experience as a physiotherapist in the field of pediatrics.
3. Teaching experience working with Physiotherapy students.
4. Additional qualifications, including postgraduate education, courses, and professional training relevant to teaching the following subjects: Clinical Foundations of Physiotherapy in Pediatrics, Physiotherapy in Pediatrics and Rehabilitation Planning in Developmental Age.
5. Active participation in scientific conferences in the field of physiotherapy.

Scope of duties:

- Delivering lectures and practical classes in the following subjects: Clinical Foundations of Physiotherapy in Pediatrics, Physiotherapy in Pediatrics, Rehabilitation Planning in Developmental Age.
- Active involvement in the research, teaching, and organizational activities of the Department of Clinical Physiotherapy, the Faculty, and the University.
- Availability and commitment to departmental activities.
- Participation in the preparation and implementation of various research projects, scientific conferences, and training events.

Documents required for recruitment:

1. Application for employment addressed to the Rector of the Józef Piłsudski University of Physical Education in Warsaw.
2. Curriculum vitae detailing professional and academic career and professional development in accordance with the EUROPAS template (<http://europass.cedefop.europa.eu/pl/home>).
3. Personal questionnaire (https://www.awf.edu.pl/_data/assets/word_doc/0007/28186/Kwestionariusz-dla-osoby-ubiegajacej-sie-o-zatrudnienie.doc).
4. A copy of the Master's degree certificate in the aforementioned fields of study and a copy of the PhD degree certificate.
5. A declaration stating that, should the candidate be successful in the competition and employed at the University of Physical Education in Warsaw (AWF Warsaw), this institution will be their primary place of work, and that the candidate will submit a statement confirming that their academic output will be attributed to the organisational unit of AWF Warsaw and counted towards the institution's staffing quota.
6. A copy of the certificates confirming completion of the required courses.
7. A statement that the candidate: has not been subject to a disciplinary penalty as referred to in Article 276(1)(7) and (8) of the Law on Higher Education and Science, possesses full legal capacity, enjoys full public rights, and has not been convicted by a final judgment for an intentional criminal offence or an intentional fiscal offence.

8. A document or statement confirming proficiency in English at B2 level – proficiency levels according to the Council of Europe (<https://www.etutor.pl/help/advancement-levels>).
9. Polish Language: Proficiency in Polish at a minimum level of C1.
10. A copy of the documents proving that the candidate possesses other skills and qualifications useful in research, teaching and organisational work (certificates, ID cards, diplomas, attestations, etc.).
11. Consent form for the processing of personal data in accordance with the template used by AWF Warsaw.

Due to the need to process the personal data of candidates applying for employment at AWF Warsaw, a prerequisite for entering the recruitment process is the inclusion of a signed Consent Form for the processing of personal data (together with the attached information clause) in accordance with the template in use at AWF Warsaw.
